BME GTK offers several Master's programmes as well as a Business and Management Ph.D. programme in English for both international and Hungarian students.



MASTER IN ENGINEERING MANAGEMENT (starting from 2023/24)

The programme prepares students to solve and coordinate complex problems in the technological and business environment, and to manage organisations operating in such an environment.



MASTER IN FINANCE

The goal of the programme is to educate economic professionals to have a global competitive edge in finance, particularly in financial analysis and risk management.

MASTER IN REGIONAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL ECONOMICS
