BME is traditionally active in international education, GTK is also involved at several points.

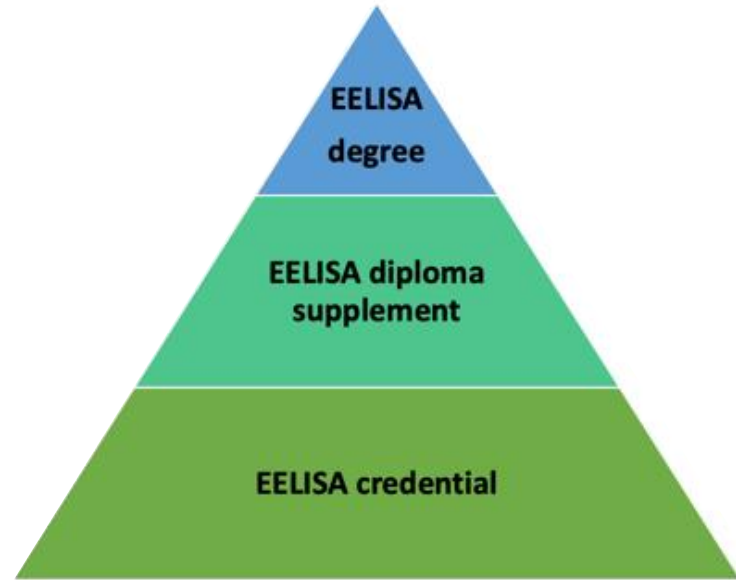

- ERASMUS+ Study scholarship
- ERASMUS+ Internships
- PES
- ATHENS



ERASMUS+ STUDY SCHOLARSHIP



- BME student enrolled for the current and following academic year
- 3-12 months
- min. 15 credits
- electronic application
- approx. 90 partner institutions abroad
- scholarship depending on the host country (approx. €550-600 per month)
- equal opportunities grant available (+ €250 per month)
- **deadline for application for the 2024/2025 academic year: beginning of February 2024**

ERASMUS+ INTERNSHIPS

- 2-12 months
- next call: December, 2023
- continuous throughout the year
- electronic application
- anywhere (Erasmus+ participating country)
- salary + scholarships at the same time
- even if the master programme does not include an internship!
- scholarship depending on the host country (approx. €690-750 per month)



PAN-EUROPEAN SEAL = PES PROGRAM

- 12-month paid internship at the EU Patent Office and the European Patent Office
- EUIPO: Alicante, EPO: München, <http://nki.bme.hu/node/5971>
- for international networking, career development
- program's structure - 3 pillar system: internship with mentoring, online courses and other trainings (e.g. career guidance), language courses
- Scholarship: EUIPO: €1000/month EPO: €2000/month
- for graduating BSc, MSc, PhD students of the member states of the European Patent Organisation (please, see: <https://www.epo.org/en/about-us/foundation/member-states>)
- expected: outstanding performance, high level of language skills
- **internal BME application deadline: 15th February 2024**



ERASMUS+ MOBILITY OUTSIDE EUROPE

- €700/month (+ travel allowance): to partner countries outside Europe, examples:
 - Australia: Technology University of Sydney
 - Singapur: National University of Singapore
 - Brasil: USP, PUCMINAS
 - South-Korea: INHA, KOREATECH, KNU, ULSAN, YONSEI
 - Japan: HOKKAIDO, SAITAMA, WASEDA
 - Taiwan: FengChia, NTU, TAIPEITECH
- €700/month (+ travel allowance): to partner countries outside Europe
- study mobility: 2-3 students / 1-2 semesters
- internship: possible if the company is approved by the Faculty
- next application period: in January 2024 for the academic year 2024/2025

ATHENS

(ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY HIGHER EDUCATION NETWORK/SOCRATES)

- Europe's 15 leading technical universities since 1997
- Approximately 150 training sessions start each year with around 5000 students.
- 1-week intensive course 2x a year (Mar, Nov)
- Courses free of charge - travel and accommodation costs should be covered by the students
- Eligible for the entire duration of studies without restriction


