The program aims to bring an opportunity to experience the cultural diversity and grandeur of China in two weeks which is fasting growing country in the world. This program is not only an academic in-class learning experience but also a diversified field course. The program is a perfect balance among study, activities, visits and trips. While it is necessary to learn Chinese language and other subject courses in a classroom setting, our program helps you apply it to the everyday environment in China. Visas and Insurance

Visa

Accepted students can apply for an appropriate visa (both "Visiting F" and "Tourist L" visas are acceptable) from their local Chinese embassy or consulate.

You will need to provide a completed application form and an official invitation letter, both of which will be provided by SWUFE after you have been accepted.



Insurance

According to the policy of China's Ministry of Education, international students must have medical and accident insurance while studying in China. Evidence of an insurance policy (purchased abroad and lasting the duration of each student's complete stay in China) must be provided upon registration.

While most visits will be free of ailments/ injuries, in the remote case something does happen it is important to understand that Chinese healthcare is **NOT** free. Having insurance avoids excessive costs and inconveniences.
