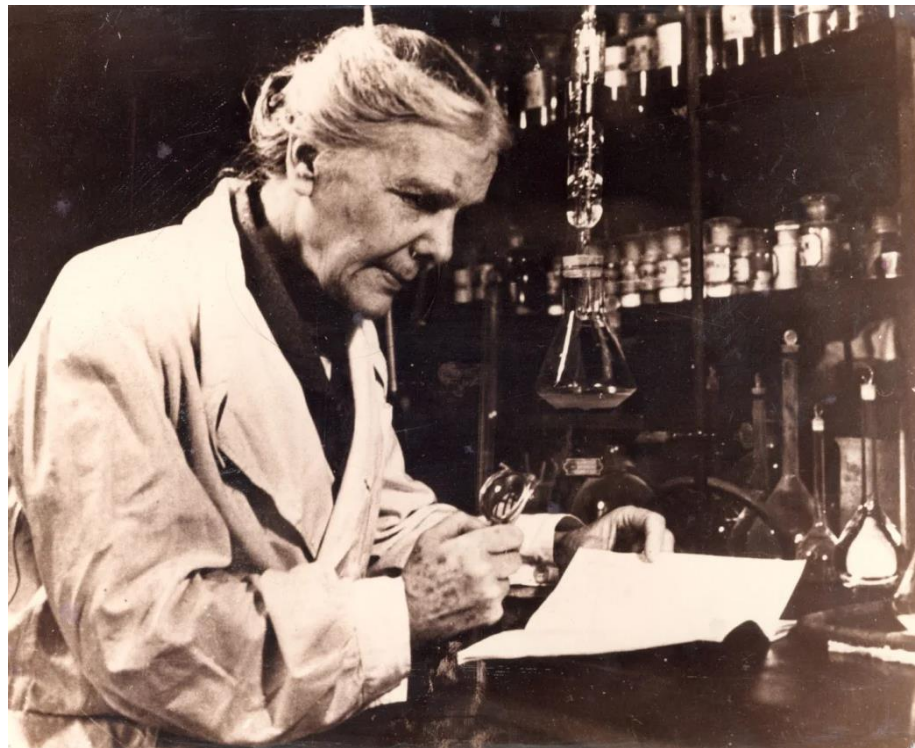

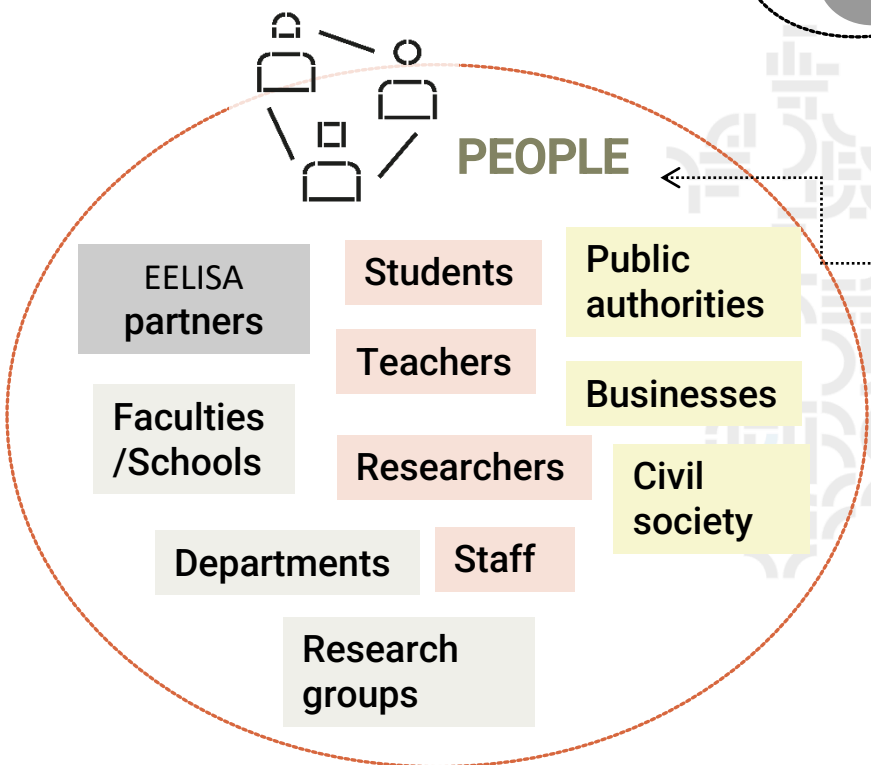

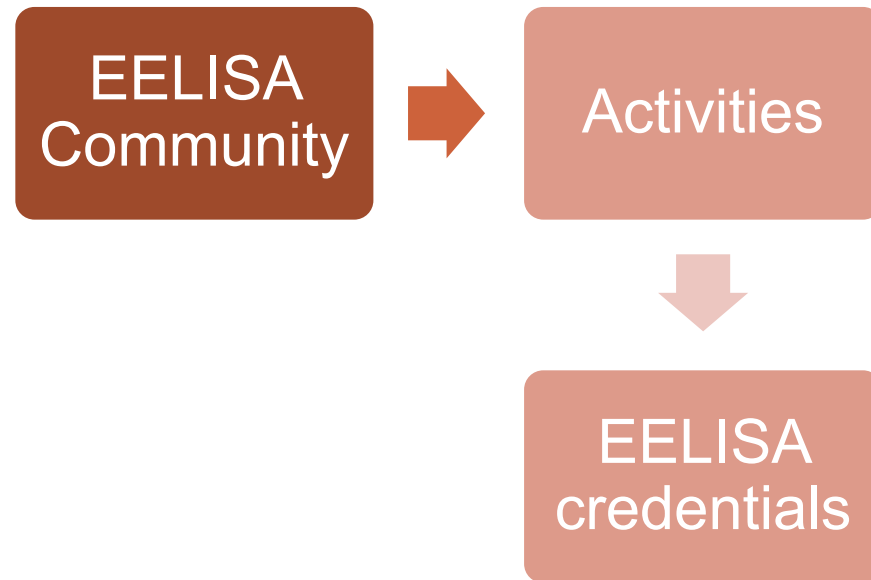
Basic philosophy

1.1. Context: EELISA Communities and economic support

Joint Calls are a way of providing competitive financial support to EELISA Communities through EELISA activities that lead to EELISA Credentials. The specific characteristics of EELISA Communities can be found on the EELISA website (<https://eelisa.eu>), but in the wider context of higher education institutions, they can be compared to Interdisciplinary Organizations or IDOs (*sensu* Yang et al., 2020¹), cross-disciplinary and multi-actor academic research teams addressing complex challenges in conjunction with the Triple Helix (industry, government, and civil society). EELISA Communities, however, can be regarded as a novel concept being less related directly to research, and more to innovative teaching methods, linking research, innovation and challenge-based learning. Joint Calls have been used to promote this linkage, emphasising the important role of education and training.

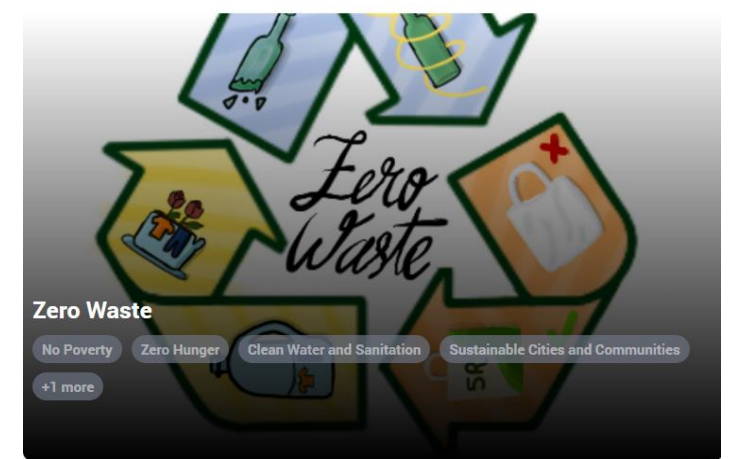

RATIONALE & SCOPE

- Promote inter-institutional activities within EELISA Communities to advance innovative teaching methods addressing SDGs.
- Special emphasis on research and innovation

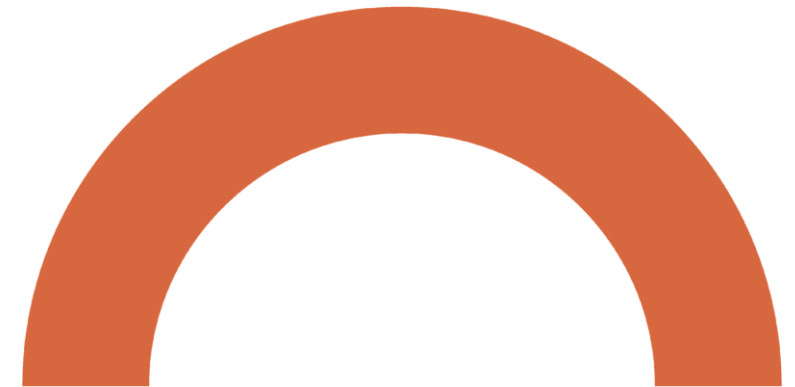
DESCRIPTION

Activities should be:

- interdisciplinary, mission-driven, and involve stakeholders from at least three EELISA partners.
- Open to all EELISA students

Evaluation criteria

- **01 Activity Description:** Innovative teaching methods (e.g., PBL, RBL, SL, CBL), participation balance, and issuance of EELISA credentials (max 50 points).
- **02 Excellence and Impact:** Relevance, novelty, and societal impact (max 30 points).
- **03 Implementation:** Execution plan, sustainability, and budget (max 20 points).

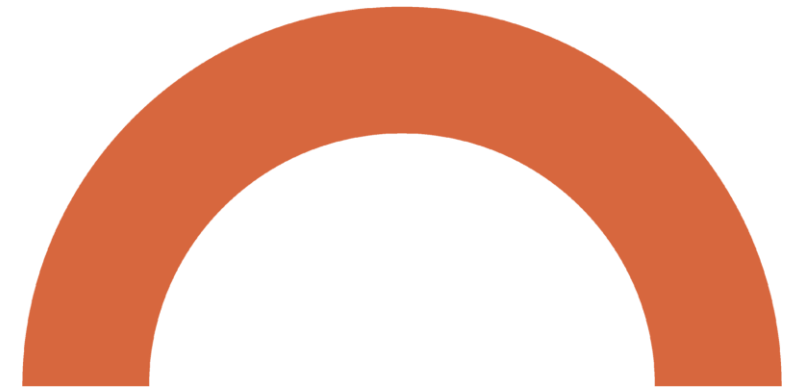

Maximum Funding per Activity: €12,000

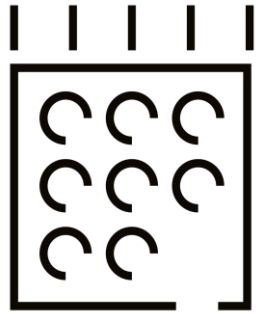
Budget Items: Organisational costs (travel, accommodation, personnel, etc.) and participation costs (for attendees).

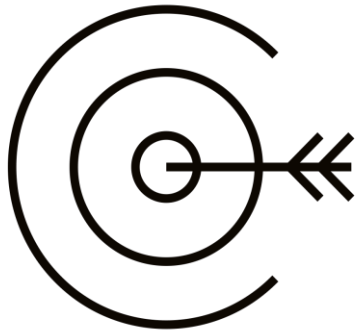

Implementation and reporting

Earliest initiation of activity proposals:

Two months after the resolution of the call (01 January 2026).

Period to carry out funded activities

Within **1 year of call publication (until 31 August 2026)**.

Deadline **to submit final** report

Within 6 weeks after the conclusion of the activity.

Digital campus

- Once approved (automatically), through your user profile, request the role 'Community Coordinator'
- Submit a Community draft through the Dashboard (<https://digitalcampus.eelisa.eu/dashboard/communities> > 'New Community' (on the bottom right of screen)
 - Mind the requirements (no. of institutions, SDGs, mission, &c. [insert applicable requirements])
- Draft is shared with WP8 for approval
- WP8 Co-Leaders get back to Community proponent on the decision, Community is approved (or not) on the Campus

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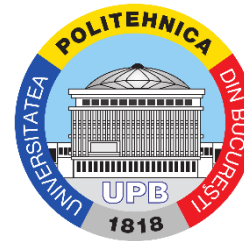
